OISAA Fall Soccer Championships and other athletics news

The early autumn athletics season is wrapping up and our students are keenly awaiting upcoming activities in November and December. In addition to our collective success in soccer, several members of our touch football team participated with distinction in the annual **Grade 7/8 OISAA Touch Football Jamboree**. At this event, students from several local independent schools are grouped together into multi-school teams for collegial play.
